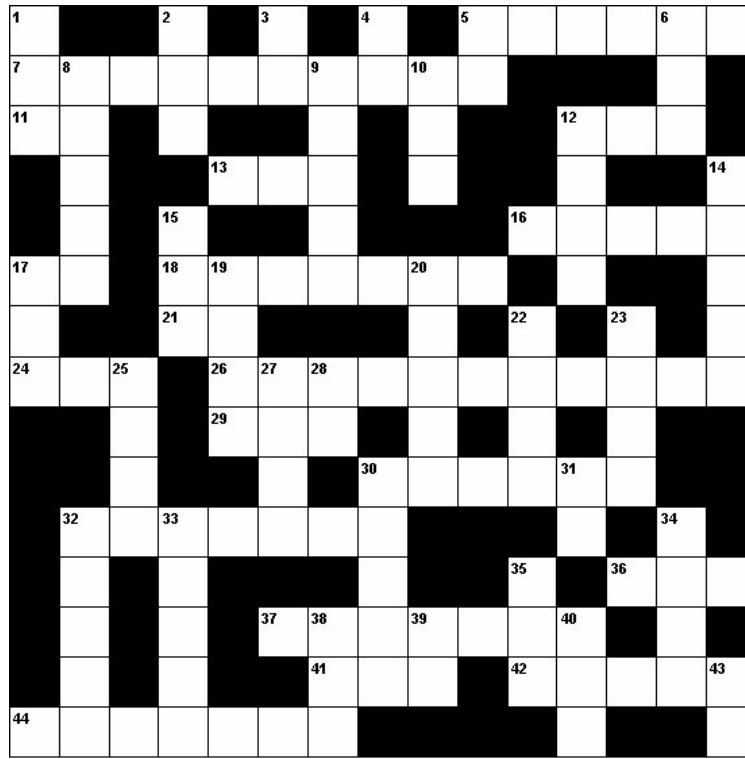


Water Crossword Puzzle
